ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ACKNOWLEDGING AUTOMATIC PARTIES, ESTABLISHING DEADLINES FOR INTERVENTION AND FOR REQUESTING A HEARING

On March 5, 2015, the Commission's Staff filed notice that on March 2, 2015, it started its prudence audit of the fuel adjustment clause established for The Empire District Electric Company for the period March 2, 2013, through February 28, 2015. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(7)(B) requires Staff to file notice regarding the commencement of an audit. That rule also requires Staff to file its recommendation regarding the audit no later than 180 days after it initiates the audit. Pursuant to the same rule, other parties to the case have 190 days after initiation of the audit to request a hearing.

The Commission will give notice of the commencement of Staff's audit to potentially interested entities and will set a date for the filing of applications to intervene. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.161(10) provides that parties to the rate case in which the Commission established the fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this prudence audit case. The Commission acknowledges the parties to ER-2012-0345 as parties to this case without the need to apply to intervene. The Data Center shall add these parties to the service list. Notice shall also be provided to parties in Empire's current rate case, ER-2014-0351.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The Commission's Data Center shall add the parties from File Number ER-2012-0345 to the certified service list for this file.
- The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this notice to each of the parties in The Empire District Electric Company's current rate case, File Number ER-2014-0351.
- 3. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than April 6, 2015. Such applications shall be filed by delivery to:

- 4. Staff shall file its recommendation no later than August 31, 2015.1
- 5. Any request for a hearing shall be filed no later than September 8, 2015.
