Granite Telecommunications, LLC ("Granite") submits to the Missouri Public Service Commission this notice of compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., FCC 11-161, Second Order on Reconsideration in Docket Nos. WC Docket No. 10-90, et al., FCC 12-47, Section 51.911(c) of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. §51.911(c).

Granite will comply with the above cited orders and rule by reducing its terminating intrastate end office rate element to \$0.0007 applicable to price-cap incumbent local exchange carriers in its operating territory per Section 51.907 of the FCC's rules, 47 C.F.R. §51.907. Granite otherwise adopts the corresponding incumbent local exchange carrier interstate terminating access rates set forth in Granite's amended Tariff F.C.C.
