ORDER CANCELING REGISTRATION

Issue Date: September 23, 2013

Effective Date: October 3, 2013

On September 3, 2013, Stouffer Communications, Inc. ("Stouffer") filed a motion to cancel the company's registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri.

In File Number DA-2011-0270, the Commission granted Stouffer its statewide IVoIP registration in the State of Missouri.

Stouffer states in its motion that the company has no customers in Missouri, and has ceased providing IVoIP services.

On September 6, 2013, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than September 16, 2013. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹


Based on Stouffer's motion, the Commission finds that the IVoIP registration granted to Stouffer Communications, Inc. shall be canceled.

1. The registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol services granted to Stouffer Communications, Inc., in File Number DA-2011-0270, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on October 3, 2013.
3. This case may be closed on October 4, 2013.
