On December 7, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting New Global Telecom, Inc.'s ("New Global") registration to provide interconnected voice over internet protocol service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. On January 28, 2010, the Commission granted New Global registration to provide IVoIP services in the State of Missouri in File Number DA-2010-0201.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Anyone wishing to respond to Staff's Motion or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than December 21, 2015, with:
