ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On April 18, 2016, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting AllVoi, Inc. (“AllVoi”) registration to provide interconnected voice over internet protocol service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. On March 3, 2012, the Commission granted AllVoi registration to provide IVolP services in the State of Missouri in File Number DA-2012-0213. On April 15, 2016, AllVoi notified the Commission that the company no longer wished to be registered as an IVolP provider in Missouri.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff’s motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff’s motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
