MISSOURI DIVISION OF ENERGY'S COMMENT ON GMO'S APPLICATION TO DISCONTINUE CERTAIN MEEIA PROGRAMS

COMES NOW the Missouri Department of Economic Development –

Division of Energy¹ ("DE") and, through counsel, offers the following comment on

KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's ("GMO") application to discontinue

certain demand-side management programs, namely its Multi-Family Rebate Program and

Energy Star New Homes programs.

Energy efficiency holds enormous untapped potential for real economic and public health gains for all Missourians. Energy efficiency in multifamily buildings, which are underserved in Missouri, especially holds potential for gains. DE takes no erosion of this potential lightly.

DE, however, will not request a hearing in this case.² This decision arises from our understanding, informed by discussions with GMO and KCP&L staff, that the companies are working to substantially bolster and redesign these concepts so that, rather than
