## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On December 23, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") submitted an application and tariff designed to implement an adjustment to its Fuel Adjustment Clause. The submitted tariff bears an effective date of March 1, 2010.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(4), the Commission's Staff shall submit a recommendation regarding the proposed adjustment no later than 30 days after the tariff's filing. No later than 60 days after receiving the proposed adjustment, the Commission must: (1) enter an interim rate adjustment; or (2) approve or reject the tariff as submitted; or (3) allow the tariff to go into effect by operation of law. Consequently, the Commission shall issue notice, set an intervention deadline, and direct its Staff to file a recommendation.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.161(10) provides that parties to the rate case in which the Commission established GMO's fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this tariff case, without the necessity of having to apply for intervention. The Commission therefore acknowledges that the parties to ER-2007-0004 are parties to this case, and will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list. GMO's FAC was modified in

Case No. ER-2009-0090 and the Commission will further direct its Data Center to add the parties of that case to the service list.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county within KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's service area.
- 2. The Commission's Data Center shall add all parties to Case Nos. ER-2007-0004 and ER-2009-0090 to the service list for this case.
- 3. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's service area and to the news media serving GMO's service area.
- 4. Any proper person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than January 13, 2010, with:

5. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall, no later than January 22, 2010, file a recommendation regarding its examination and analysis of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's application.
