On August 22, 2013, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion seeking clarification or reconsideration of the Commission's August 14 Order Revising Procedural Schedule. That order directed the parties to file surrebuttal or cross-surrebuttal testimony, specifically directing them to file testimony regarding the existence of any "studies, reports, or other documents examining alternative sites, options, or possibilities." The order also indicated the parties are not limited to that single issue and may address other issues in surrebuttal testimony. It is that last phrase that prompts Ameren Missouri to question the extent to which other parties would be allowed to address other issues in surrebuttal testimony.

The Commission will establish a time for other parties to respond to Ameren Missouri's motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Motion for Clarification or, alternatively, Motion for Reconsideration of August 14, 2013 Order Revising Procedural Schedule shall do so no later than August 26, 2013.
