Under cover of my letter you will find a Notice of Dismissal of Weber Gas Energy, LLC's application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to offer and provide regulated gas service. The Company is withdrawing the CCN application to give it more time to consider viable options for the efficient use of this renewable energy resource that is produced by affiliated landfill operations. These options include review of outside proposals the Company has received for expanding the capabilities of the North Complex to provide electrical power generation to additional users. Weber Gas Energy, LLC will continue to provide landfill gas to Pattonville High School, Jaguar Green Houses, and Breckenridge Concrete. The Company will also continue to supply fuel for the Fred Weber, Inc. north asphalt plant as an alternative energy source.
