ORDER CANCELING REGISTRATION

Issue Date: May 6, 2016

Effective Date: May 16, 2016

On April 13, 2016, Staff filed a motion requesting the Commission cancel MegaPath Corporation's, ("MegaPath") registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri. The Commission granted MegaPath its IVoIP registration in the State of Missouri in File No. DA-2009-0074.

Staff states in its motion that on December 21, 2015, the company notified the Commission that it no longer wished to be registered as an IVoIP provider in Missouri.

On April 14, 2016, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing no later than April 25, 2016. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹

Based on MegaPath's request and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the IVoIP registration granted to MegaPath Corporation shall be canceled.

1. The registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol services granted to MegaPath Corporation, in File Number DA-2009-0074, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on May 16, 2016.
3. This case may be closed on May 17, 2016.
