## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On June 17, 2021, the Staff of the Public Service Commission filed a pleading advising the Commission to cancel the IVolP registration of Carousel Industries of North America, Inc. (Carousel) at that company's request. The Commission granted Carousel a registration of authority to provide interconnected voice over internet protocol (IVolP) service on November 17, 2020, in File No. DA-2021-0140.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's recommendation and the company's request.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days to file a motion for hearing.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Anyone wishing to respond to Staff's recommendation or request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than July 1, 2021.
