**RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER – AMENDED RECONCILIATION**

**COMES NOW** The Empire District Electric Company (“Empire” or “Company”), and for its Response to Commission Order, respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

- 1. RSMo. §386.420.4 requires the Commission to prepare and approve a detailed reconciliation, with input from the parties, regarding the dollar value and rate or charge impact of contested issues decided by the Commission in the case.
- 2. On September 11, 2020, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Reconciliation*, directing Empire to file the reconciliation contemplated by RSMo. §386.420.4.
- 3. Pursuant to RSMo. §386.420.4 and the Commission’s *Order Directing Reconciliation*, on September 21, 2020, Empire proposed a reconciliation. Since this initial submission, Empire continued to work with the Staff of the Commission on the correct numbers. In this regard, an amended proposed reconciliation is attached hereto.

**WHEREFORE**, Empire submits its Response to Commission Order and requests such relief as is just and proper under the circumstances.
