On March 7, 2022, the Commission issued an order suspending the procedural schedule in these cases, directing Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (collectively "Evergy") to file a status report apprising the Commission whether settlement discussions are likely to produce a settlement agreement. Evergy filed its third status report on May 23, 2022, stating that the parties have been conducting settlement discussions and requesting additional time to file a settlement agreement or another status report by June 6, 2022.

The Commission finds Evergy's request reasonable and will order Evergy to file a settlement agreement or another status report no later than June 6, 2022.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West shall file either a settlement agreement or another status report apprising the Commission whether

settlement discussions are likely to produce a settlement agreement, no later than June 6, 2022.
