ORDER FURTHER MODIFYING PROTECTIVE ORDER

Issue Date: May 10, 2022 Effective Date: May 10, 2022

On May 6, 2022, Co-Mo Electric Cooperative (Co-Mo) filed a motion to further modify the protective order to allow an additional expert, retired electric cooperative manager Richard Fowler, to view highly confidential information in connection with this matter. In support of its motion Co-Mo states that it has consulted with counsel for Ameren Missouri, who does not object to allowing Richard Fowler to view the information.

Also on May 6, 2022, the Staff of the Commission filed a response to Co-Mo's motion stating it had no issues with Mr. Fowler viewing highly confidential information, but objects to Mr. Fowler testifying in this matter.

The Commission will modify the protective order, but will not address whether Mr. Fowler will be allowed to testify at this time.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Co-Mo's protective order is modified as follows:
 - a. Materials and information divulged by Ameren Missouri, or other parties, shall be considered "Highly Confidential" if so designated at the time of disclosure.

- b. In addition to Dan Beck who was previously authorized to view highly confidential information, Richard Fowler, retied electric cooperative manager may view Ameren Missouri's highly confidential information in preparing Co-Mo's case. Mr. Fowler shall:
 - i. Keep all information secure;
 - ii. Maintain highly confidential documents in a secured computer system under their exclusive control. Such documents shall not be commingled with or released to any other computer system except that of counsel for Co-Mo;
 - iii. Submit the non-disclosure form attached to this order as Exhibit

 A and file it with the Commission before viewing highly confidential information;
 - iv. Within ninety days after the completion of this proceeding, including judicial review, destroy or permanently delete all electronic and paper copies of all highly confidential information, notes, work papers, and copies preserved in the hard drives of computers, copy machines, and devices with similar capacity;
 - v. Adhere to the confidentiality requirements of 20 CSR 4240-2.135(13).
- c. Counsel for Co-Mo shall utilize secure methods for transferring information to and from the secured computer systems.

- d. Persons afforded access to materials or information designated "Highly Confidential" shall neither use nor disclose such materials or information for purposes of business or competition or any other purpose other than in regard to the case referenced above and shall keep the materials and information secure and confidential and in accordance with the purposes and intent of this protective order.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
