ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On September 4, 2013, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed the above referenced application and tariff. On September 5, the Commission set a procedural schedule.

On September 17, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule. Staff stated that people responsible for preparing surrebuttal testimony will be out of the office from September 16 through 20. Thus, Staff asks for one additional day, from September 23 to September 24, for all parties to file surrebuttal. Staff represents that no party objects.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule is granted.
2. Surrebuttal testimony shall be filed no later than September 24, 2013.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
