**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO  
MOTION FOR EXPEDITED APPROVAL OF TARIFF**

KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed a tariff revision on September 29, 2014, to amend its MEEIA Program Income-Eligible Weatherization tariff to reallocate certain funds, and to add explanatory language describing the reallocation of funds. The tariff revision carries an October 29 effective date, but GMO has filed a motion for expedited treatment asking the Commission to approve the tariff revision to take effect on October 9.

If the Commission is to approve GMO's tariff revision to be effective on October 9, it will need to act at its October 8 agenda meeting. Therefore, the Commission will establish a shortened time for the filing of responses to GMO's motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any party wishing to respond to KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's Motion for Expedited Treatment and its tariff revision shall do so no later than October 6, 2014.

2. Staff shall file its recommendation regarding KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's Motion for Expedited Treatment and its tariff revision no later than October 6, 2014.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
