**STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE TARIFF SHEET AND REQUEST FOR  
EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, by and through counsel, and for its recommendation states:

1. In the attached Memorandum (Appendix A), Staff recommends the Commission issue an order that both approves GMO's revised tariff sheet relating to the reallocation of income-eligible weatherization program funds among the agencies administering the programs, as filed on September 29, 2014, and, for good cause shown make the tariff sheet effective on October 9, 2014, rather than October 29, 2014.
2. Section 393.140(11), RSMo 2000, requires that proposed changes to tariffs not go into effect with less than thirty (30) days' notice, unless the Commission determines otherwise for "good cause shown."
3. GMO has shown good cause for expedited approval of the tariff sheet because it will make weatherization funds available to GMO income eligible customers in a timelier manner and there will be no negative effects on GMO's customers.
4. The Staff has verified that GMO has filed its annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. Staff is not aware of any other matter before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff has reviewed the filed tariff sheet and recommends approving the following tariff sheet as filed on September 29, 2014, and recommends granting the expedited treatment request to allow the tariff sheet to take effect on October 9, 2014.

DATE: October 3, 2014

On September 29, 2014, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”), filed its “REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF TARIFF AND A MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT relating to a tariff revision for its Income-Eligible Weatherization program (“Program”).

On September 30, 2014, the Commission issued ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION FOR EXPEDITED APPROVAL OF TARIFF ordering that “any party wishing to respond to KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company’s Motion for Expedited Treatment and its tariff revision shall do so no later than October 6, 2014.”

The tariff revision consists of: (1) reallocation of funds from United Services to West Central Missouri Community Action; and (2) explanatory language below the allocation table describing the reallocation of funds. This filing is a reallocation of funds from one community action agency to another. This tariff sheet contains an issue date of September 29, 2014.

The change in the allocation of funds is occurring due to United Services not being able to use any of its allotted weatherization funds for this program year due to unforeseen changes within the agency while ramping up to take over the weatherization program from the City of Kansas City.

The tariff sheet carries an effective date of October 29, 2014. However, GMO seeks the Commission’s expedited treatment of this tariff sheet to become effective October 9, 2014. These proposed changes were presented to, and approved by the DSM Advisory Group (“DSMAG”).

The Staff has verified that GMO has filed its annual report and is not delinquent on any assessment. Staff is not aware of any other matter before the Commission that affects or is affected by this filing.

### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed the filed tariff sheet and recommends approving the following tariff sheet as filed on September 29, 2014, and recommends granting the expedited treatment request to allow the tariff sheet to take effect on October 9, 2014. GMO has demonstrated good cause shown for expedited



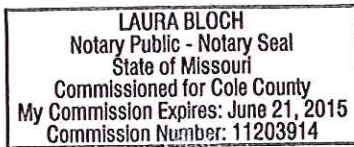
