NOTICE AND ORDER SETTING DATES FOR FILINGS

Kansas City Power & Light Company filed the pending tariff,¹ proposing to suspend the payment of solar rebates, and an application seeking approval of the tariff.² The tariff bears a proposed effective date of March 18, 2016, and the Commission must rule on the tariff within sixty days of the tariff's filing date.³ The application also includes a motion to waive the need for any motion to intervene as to "the parties in File No. ET-2014-0071[,]"⁴ and make each such participant an intervenor in this action ("motion"). Because of the accelerated schedule prescribed for this action, the Commission will grant the motion,⁵ and will also set the date for responsive filings as follows.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The motion is granted and the persons described in the body of this order are deemed intervenors. Any deemed intervenor may file a response to the application and tariff. Any such response shall be filed no later than February 3, 2016.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
