On November 25, 2019, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an Application for Approval to Expand Community Solar Pilot Program and Associated Tariff. The Commission directed notice of the application, and ordered a Recommendation from Staff no later than December 12, 2019. Staff recommended that the Commission suspend the tariff, and the Commission suspended the tariff until March 25, 2020.

The Commission ordered Staff to file a status report. Staff filed its report on February 24, 2020. That report stated that the Staff and Ameren Missouri hope to continue discussing the issues after the Commission has issued its order in File No. ER-2019-0355.

The parties are welcome to negotiate their disputes in this case. But the tariff effective date is March 25, 2020. Thus, the Commission must have a Staff Recommendation or alternative pleading from Staff. If Staff believes the parties wish to continue negotiating past March 25, 2020, then Staff may move the Commission for further suspension of the tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation or alternative pleading no later than March 2, 2020.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
