STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and for its *Status Report*, states as follows:

1. On November 25, 2019, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren”) filed an *Application for Approval to Expand Community Solar Pilot Program and Associated Tariff*.

2. On December 12, 2019, Staff requested that the Commission suspend the tariff for 90 days to allow time for Staff to complete discovery. The Commission granted Staff’s request on December 17, 2019, ordering the tariff suspended until March 25, 2020.

3. Similarities between the issues in this case and those arising from Ameren’s current general rate case in File No. ER-2019-0335 have been the focus for both Staff and Ameren. As to issues that are not being addressed in the general rate case, Staff and Ameren hope to continue those discussions following the issuance of a Commission Order in File No. ER-2019-0335.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this *Status Report* for the Commission’s information and consideration.
