**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE**  
**WITH COMMISSION ORDER**

Issue Date: December 28, 2005

Effective Date: January 16, 2006

On November 17, 2005, the Commission approved AmerenUE's request for a metering rule and metering tariff variance. That order directed AmerenUE to file a tariff that listed the approved variances.

On December 16, AmerenUE filed tariff sheet P.S.C. MO. Schedule No. 5, 9<sup>th</sup> Revised SHEET NO. 203, Canceling 8<sup>th</sup> Revised SHEET No. 203. The sheet bears an effective date of January 16, 2006. On December 27, the Staff of the Commission filed its Recommendation. Staff stated that the tariff sheet complies with the Commission order and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff sheet.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet and the Staff Recommendation. The Commission determines that the tariff sheet complies with the applicable statutes and this Commission's November 17 order. The Commission will approve the tariff sheet.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the following tariff sheet in Tariff No. YE-2006-0462, issued December 16, 2005, is hereby approved to become effective on January 16, 2006:
