KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (KCPL GMO) filed a request for waivers of certain rules related to its planned August 2009 Integrated Resource Plan reporting requirements. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed responses to that application.

In their responses DNR and Staff each indicate no opposition to the requested waivers so long as certain conditions are met. KCPL GMO has not responded to the filings of DNR or Staff. The Commission will direct KCPL GMO to reply to the filings of DNR and Staff with regard to the conditions recommended. Any other party wishing to comment shall also do so as set out below.

If no request for a hearing is received, then the Commission may make its decision based on the pleadings.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall file a response to the recommendations of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission no later than February 9, 2009.

2. Any other party wishing to respond to the recommendations of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall do so no later than February 9, 2009.

3. Any requests for hearing in this matter shall be filed no later than February 9, 2009.

4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
