ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On October 29, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed a joint application asking the Commission to waive a provision of the Commission's renewable energy standards rule to allow the applicants to delay filing a standard offer contract for the purchase of solar renewable energy credits beyond the November 1 submission date specified in the rule.¹ The Applicants filed a motion for expedited treatment along with their application, asking the Commission to approve the application "as soon as possible."

KCP&L and KCPL-GMO did not file their application until 11:52 a.m. on the Friday before Monday, November 1. Obviously, there will not be a reasonable opportunity for any interested party to respond to the application before November 1. Therefore, the Commission will not be able to act on the application before the November 1 tariff submission date specified in the regulation. However, the Commission will consider the application expeditiously, while respecting the interests of any parties who may oppose the

application. To that end, the Commission will establish a time in which any party wishing to respond to the application may do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to the Joint Application of Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall do so no later than November 18, 2010.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
