ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION FOR EXPEDITED APPROVAL OF TARIFF

KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed a tariff revision on September 22, 2014, to amend its Residential Lighting and Appliance Program to remove two measures from the "Eligible Lighting and Appliance Measures" section of the tariff. The tariff revision carries an October 22 effective date, but GMO filed a motion for expedited treatment asking the Commission to approve the tariff revision to take effect on October 2.

On September 23, the Commission issued an order directing that any party wishing to respond to GMO's motion for expedited approval, do so by September 29. On that date, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking for an additional week to file a recommendation regarding GMO's tariff. Staff explains that it needs more time to obtain and review information about the proposed tariff. Staff also represents that it has contacted GMO and Public Counsel about the request for extension and that neither object to the extension of time to respond.

The Commission will grant the extension requested by Staff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's Motion for Expedited Treatment shall do so no later than October 8, 2014.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
