ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION

On July 2, 2021, The Empire District Electric Company, a Liberty Utilities company (Empire-Liberty) filed new tariff sheets for its Community Solar Pilot Program. Empire-Liberty's implementing tariff bears an effective date of August 1, 2021. The Commission ordered Staff to file a recommendation no later than July 13, 2021.

On July 13, 2021, Staff filed a Motion for Extension. Staff states that the parties have discussed the pending tariff sheets and potential changes thereto. Thus, Staff asks for an extension of time until the morning of July 19, 2021 to file its recommendation.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The motion for extension of time is granted.
2. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation on Tariff No. YE-2022-0004 no later than noon, July 19, 2021.
3. Any response to the Staff recommendation shall be filed no later than noon, July 20, 2021.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
