ORDER APPROVING SECOND COMPLIANCE TARIFF FILING

On October 27, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its *Application, Request for Variances, and Request for Accounting Authority* to implement an electrification pilot program. On March 10, 2021, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement*, approving an agreement between the parties and granting the requested variances and deferral accounting mechanism. Ameren Missouri was ordered to file tariff sheets in compliance with the Commission's order. Ameren Missouri filed compliance tariff sheets, which the Commission approved.

On April 28, 2022, Ameren Missouri filed revised compliance tariff sheets, Tariff No. YE-2022-0251, to implement item eleven of the *Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement* approved on March 10, 2021. The Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation concerning the compliance tariff sheets and set a time for other comments. Staff filed a recommendation on May 13, 2022, advising the Commission to approve the tariff sheets. No other comments were received.

After reviewing the tariff sheets and the Staff recommendation, the Commission finds that Ameren Missouri's tariff sheets comply with the Commission's March 10, 2021, order and will approve them. So that Ameren Missouri can implement the compliance

tariff sheets on their effective date, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than thirty days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff sheets filed by Ameren Missouri on April 28, 2022, assigned Tariff No. YE-2022-0251, are approved to become effective on May 28, 2022. The specific tariff sheets approved are:
