2 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Welcome, everyone, to the
3 pre-hearing conference in Case No. ET-2007-0459 which
4 concerns AmerenUE's Tariff to establish an Industrial
5 Demand Response Program.

6 I've asked you today for this pre-hearing
7 conference so we can discuss how we want to proceed in
8 this case.

9 We'll begin by taking entries of appearance,
10 beginning with Ameren.

13 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And for Staff.

14 MR. FREY: Dennis L. Frey representing the
15 Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post
16 Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri.

17 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Office of the Public
18 Counsel.

19 MR. DANDINO: Michael Dandino and Lewis R.
20 Mills from the Office of Public Counsel, Post Office
21 Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, representing
22 the Office of the Public Counsel and the public.

23 JUDGE WOODRUFF: For the Missouri Energy
24 Group.

25 MS. LANGENECKERT: Lisa C. Langeneckert,

3 Missouri Energy Group.

4 JUDGE WOODRUFF: For Missouri Industrial
5 Energy Consumers.

6 MS. ILES: My name is Carol Iles, I'm also
7 entering an appearance on behalf of Diana Vuylsteke,
8 from Brian Cave, L.L.P., our address is 211 North
9 Broadway, Suite 3600, St. Louis, Missouri.

10 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Is there anyone here from
11 Noranda Aluminum?

12 I had an e-mail exchange with Mr. Conrad last
13 week, and he said he would probably not be attending.
14 He indicated that his client was more interested in
15 monitoring than actively participating.

16 As I indicated, the purpose of today's conference
17 was to give the parties a chance to work on a proposed
18 procedural schedule. Of course, if you can all reach
19 an agreement that will be wonderful as well.

20 I will tell you what the Commission told me in
21 agenda when we discussed this case last, they want to
22 make sure they have an IDR program in place before
23 next summer. So, keep that in mind when you are
24 talking about your procedural schedules.

25 I think the Commission's schedule is fairly clear

1 for February and March, that area. Of course, you can
2 come upstairs and check the schedule as you need to.

3 I'll ask you to prepare a proposed procedural
4 schedule and file it by a week from today, December 4.
5 And hopefully you can all agree upon a procedural
6 schedule. If you can't, you can file competing
7 schedules and the Commission will decide.

8 Are there any matters you want to bring up while
9 we're on the record? All right, I don't see any
10 response. So, with that, the on-the-record portion of
11 this pre-hearing conference is adjourned, and I'll
12 leave you to your discussions.
