3 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Good afternoon. We are on the  
4 record. This is the Prehearing Conference in Case No.  
5 ET-2014-0026.

6 I'm Ron Pridgin, Regulatory Law Judge, appointed  
7 to preside at this meeting on August 21st, 2013. We are  
8 in the Governor Office Building in Jefferson City,  
9 Missouri, and the time is 1:00 in the afternoon.

10 I would like to get entries of appearance from  
11 counsel, please. I think I've got everyone, and I'll go  
12 through what I believe is the exhaustive list of parties,  
13 and then I'll see if I've missed anybody.

14 So, beginning with KCPL GMO, please.

15 MR. FISCHER: Yes. Let the record reflect the  
16 appearance of James M. Fischer and Larry W. Dority. Our  
17 law firm is Fischer and Dority, P.C. Our address is 101

20 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Fischer, thank you. Mr.

2 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Ms. Hernandez, Mr.

7 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Poston, thank you.

24 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Knee, thank you.

1 MS. BROWN: Susan Brown. We're at 1617 Main,  
2 Kansas City, Missouri. I think I put my home address on  
3 it.

4 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. We can certainly  
5 correct that later, if you would like, Ms. Brown. Thank  
6 you.

7 Have I overlooked anyone, please?

8 MR. DOWNEY: Edward Downey on behalf of the MIEC.  
9 My address is 221 Bolivar Street, Suite 101, Jefferson  
10 City, Missouri, 65102.

11 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you.

12 MR. CARROLL: Steven Carroll with Carroll &  
13 Associates, 215 East Capitol, Jefferson City, Missouri,  
14 65101, on behalf of MOSEIA.

15 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Carroll, thank you.

16 Anyone else?

17 (No response.)

18 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Let me ask of the  
19 parties, is there anything that you want or need to bring  
20 to my attention before I go on? And I don't have a whole  
21 lot more, but anything you need to bring to my attention?

22 (Indicating.)

23 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Ms. Tatro?

24 MS. TATRO: I just wanted to clarify that everyone  
25 who had intervened in the Res complaint's plan initially



1 is made a party to this case. I haven't intervened in a  
2 straight reply in this case. You asked me to bring it up  
3 at this.

4 JUDGE PRIDGIN: It is my understanding and  
5 intention to kind of cache out this tariff part, kind of  
6 go with two different cases. I certainly intended  
7 everyone who is a party -- and I believe it was the 0505  
8 case, if I remember correctly -- would also automatically  
9 be a party to this one. And that appears everybody is  
10 here and has that understanding as well. I'm seeing  
11 people nod heads.

12 MS. TATRO: Thank you.

13 JUDGE PRIDGIN: You're quite welcome. I did not  
14 mean to exclude anything if I excluded anything. Thank  
15 you.

16 I didn't put in the order setting the prehearing,  
17 but I would normally ask the parties to file either a  
18 proposed procedural schedule or competing schedules within  
19 a week. So, if I could get those -- today is 21st, so by  
20 August 28th, and I believe the tariff is suspended until  
21 early October. And, so, you know, with that deadline in  
22 mind, that may influence how -- what your schedule is or  
23 if you want to ask the Commission to further suspend the  
24 tariff to meet another deadline. So, I did want to remind  
25 parties of the tariff effective date that's hanging out

1 there.

2 Is there anything further from the parties?

3 (Indicating.)

4 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Fischer?

5 MR. FISCHER: Judge, I would just note that, at  
6 least from the Company's perspective, it's important that  
7 we resolve these issues -- or the Commission resolve the  
8 issues as soon as possible so that we know whether we're  
9 going to continue to be paying solar rebates and/or into  
10 what extent those will continue to be paid. And it's  
11 going to determine the amount of money that other  
12 customers are going to be paying relating to the solar  
13 rebates.

14 From our perspective, that deadline that you  
15 mentioned is a good deadline, October 3rd. Initially, we  
16 filed the case back in July -- early July. Under the new  
17 statute, the Commission has only 60 days if you would file  
18 under that particular solar statute. So, we think it's  
19 very important that we try to get a schedule that would  
20 work so the Commission can resolve the issues by that  
21 date.

22 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Okay. Very good. Mr. Fischer,  
23 thank you.

24 Anything else from the parties before I excuse  
25 myself?

1 (No response.)

2 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. I believe you'll have  
3 access to this room the rest of the afternoon. I am on  
4 the 9th Floor. If anybody needs to see me about  
5 scheduling issues or to look for hearing dates, that's  
6 where we keep a calendar.

7 If there's nothing further?

8 (No response.)

9 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Very good. We are off  
10 the record for this Prehearing Conference of ET-2014-0026.  
11 Thank you. We're off the record.
