- 5 intention to kind of cache out this tariff part, kind of
- 6 go with two different cases. I certainly intended
- 7 everyone who is a party -- and I believe it was the 0505
- 8 case, if I remember correctly -- would also automatically
- 9 be a party to this one. And that appears everybody is
- 10 here and has that understanding as well. I'm seeing
- 11 people nod heads.
- MS. TATRO: Thank you.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: You're quite welcome. I did not
- 14 mean to exclude anything if I excluded anything. Thank
- 15 you.
- 16 I didn't put in the order setting the prehearing,
- 17 but I would normally ask the parties to file either a
- 18 proposed procedural schedule or competing schedules within
- 19 a week. So, if I could get those -- today is 21st, so by
- 20 August 28th, and I believe the tariff is suspended until
- 21 early October. And, so, you know, with that deadline in
- 22 mind, that may influence how -- what your schedule is or
- 23 if you want to ask the Commission to further suspend the
- 24 tariff to meet another deadline. So, I did want to remind
- 25 parties of the tariff effective date that's hanging out

2	Is there anything further from the parties?
3	(Indicating.)
4	JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Fischer?
5	MR. FISCHER: Judge, I would just note that, at
6	least from the Company's perspective, it's important that
7	we resolve these issues or the Commission resolve the
8	issues as soon as possible so that we know whether we're
9	going to continue to be paying solar rebates and/or into
10	what extent those will continue to be paid. And it's
11	going to determine the amount of money that other
12	customers are going to be paying relating to the solar
13	rebates.
14	From our perspective, that deadline that you
15	mentioned is a good deadline, October 3rd. Initially, we
16	filed the case back in July early July. Under the new
17	statute, the Commission has only 60 days if you would file
18	under that particular solar statute. So, we think it's
19	very important that we try to get a schedule that would
20	work so the Commission can resolve the issues by that
21	date.
22	JUDGE PRIDGIN: Okay. Very good. Mr. Fischer,
23	thank you.
24	Anything else from the parties before I excuse
25	myself?
