ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, A STAFF RECOMMENDATION, AND SETTING A DEADLINE FOR INTERVENTION

On May 27, 2022, Co-Mo Electric Cooperative and Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (collectively, "Applicants") filed a stipulation and agreement along with a territorial agreement in File No. EO-2022-0190. The Applicants contemplate the approval of the stipulation and agreement along with the territorial agreement.

The law requires the Commission to rule on the application no later than 120 days from the application's filing date, and provides the right to a hearing.¹ However, a hearing may be waived by agreement of the parties.²

The statutes provide that "notice of such filing shall be given to other electrical suppliers pursuant to the rules and regulations of the commission governing applications for certificates of public convenience and necessity."³ No regulation contains any provision for notice with regard to certificates of public convenience and necessity. Therefore, the

Commission will order notice delivered to elected officials and published in newspapers, set a deadline for intervention, and direct the filing of a staff recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the county commissioners of Cooper, Cole, and Moniteau Counties, Missouri.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make this notice available to the members of the General Assembly representing Cooper, Cole, and Moniteau Counties, Missouri and to the newspapers and other media serving those counties.

3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than June 15, 2022.

4. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation on the territorial agreement no later than June 15, 2022.

5. This order is effective when issued.
