**ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING**

On May 28, 2014, the Commission issued its Order Approving Tariff.<sup>1</sup> Both the order and the tariff became effective on June 8. On June 9, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri") applied for rehearing.

The Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear."<sup>2</sup> The Commission finds that the applicant failed to establish such a sufficient reason. Thus, the Commission will deny the application.

In addition, Renew Missouri did not timely apply for rehearing. To be timely, an applicant must ask for rehearing **before** the effective date.<sup>3</sup>

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Application for Rehearing is denied.
