Missouri ("Renew Missouri") applied for rehearing.

The Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient

reason therefor be made to appear."<sup>2</sup> The Commission finds that the applicant failed to

establish such a sufficient reason. Thus, the Commission will deny the application.

In addition, Renew Missouri did not timely apply for rehearing. To be timely, an

applicant must ask for rehearing before the effective date.<sup>3</sup>

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application for Rehearing is denied.
