ORDER APPROVING EXPEDITED TARIFF

Issue Date: October 8, 2014

Effective Date: October 9, 2014

On September 29, 2014, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) issued a tariff to amend its MEEIA Program Income-Eligible Weatherization tariff to reallocate certain funds, and to add explanatory language describing the reallocation of funds. The tariff carries an October 29 effective date, but GMO asks the Commission to approve the tariff to take effect on October 9.

The Commission ordered that any party wishing to respond to GMO's motion for expedited approval of its tariff do so no later than October 6. The Commission also ordered its Staff to file a recommendation no later than October 6. Public Counsel filed a response on October 6 indicating it does not object to the tariff. On the same date, Commission's Staff filed its recommendation advising the Commission to approve the tariff to be effective on October 9 as requested. No other party has filed a recommendation regarding the tariff

Based on the recommendation of its Staff, and the non-opposition of Public Counsel, the Commission finds that the submitted tariff should be approved on less than thirty days' notice.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The proposed tariff sheet submitted under Tariff No. JE-2015-0133 by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company is approved, effective on and after October 9, 2014.
