ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

On January 6, 2016, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an *Order Regarding Tariff*, effective January 16, 2016, approving tariff sheets related to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's street lighting. On January 15, 2016, the Office of the Public Counsel applied for rehearing. No parties responded to the application.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, states that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel has not shown sufficient reason to rehear the matter. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Office of the Public Counsel's Application for Rehearing is denied.

2. This order shall become effective when issued.
