**COMES NOW** the Office of the Public Counsel and moves the Commission to extend the time for it to file its recommendation on KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's proposed tariff sheets designed to revise its estimated billing and budget billing practices from the currently ordered date of April 6, 2018, to April 13, 2018, to allow time for the Office of the Public Counsel and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company to confer further about remaining concerns the Office of the Public Counsel has with KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's planned implementation of its estimated billing and budget billing practices in an effort to resolve those concerns before the Office of the Public Counsel files its recommendation. The Office of the Public Counsel has contacted counsel Roger Steiner for KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company who has authorized undersigned counsel to represent that KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company does not oppose this request. The Office of the Public Counsel is filing a similar request in Case No. ET-2018-0158 where Kansas City Power & Light Company has filed complementary tariff sheets.
