## ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND DIRECTING FILING OF STATUS REPORT

On February 11, 2021, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule and a request for expedited treatment. The Commission previously established a procedural schedule with rebuttal testimony due no later than February 12, 2021. The motion states that the parties have been engaging in settlement communications and are confident that a settlement can be reached. Accordingly, they ask that the procedural schedule be suspended so efforts can be focused on settlement.

The Commission will grant the motion to suspend the procedural schedule and request for expedited treatment. The Commission will set a deadline for the parties to file a status report should a settlement not be reached.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The procedural schedule is suspended. The evidentiary hearing scheduled for March 11-12, 2021, is canceled.
2. The parties shall file a copy of any agreement reached or a status report on this matter no later than March 1, 2021.

3. This order is effective when issued.
