ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF SHEETS AND DIRECTING FILING

On January 13, 2023, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed tariff sheets, assigned Tracking No. JE-2023-0124, designed to revise Ameren Missouri's rates paid for energy purchased from customers with a Qualifying Facility or Net Metering installation as required by Commission Rules 20 CSR 4240-3.155, 20 CSR 4240-20.060, and 20 CSR 4240-20.065. The tariff sheets have an effective date of February 12, 2023.

On February 3, 2023, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion to suspend the tariff sheets and a motion for expedited treatment. Staff requested the Commission suspend the tariff sheets to allow sufficient time for Staff to conduct discovery necessary to make an informed recommendation to the Commission.

The Commission shortened the response time to Staff's motion and directed Staff to give an estimate of when it expected to file its recommendation. On February 7, 2023, Staff filed a response saying it estimates it will file its recommendation on May 23, 2023. No other responses were received.

Section 393.150.1, RSMo, authorizes the Commission to suspend the operation of proposed tariff sheets for up to 120 days beyond the date when such sheets would otherwise go into effect. As indicated by Staff, the proposed effective date does not allow

adequate time for Commission review of Ameren Missouri's tariff sheets. Therefore, the Commission will suspend the tariff sheets for 120 days beyond the proposed effective date to provide for review and consideration. The Commission will also set a time for the filing of Staff's recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff sheets filed by Ameren Missouri and assigned Tracking No. JE-2023-0124 are suspended for 120 days until June 12, 2023.
2. Staff shall file its recommendation no later than May 23, 2023.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
