NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

Issue Date: April 13, 2007

On June 30, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed an application for an Accounting Authority Order (AAO) regarding pension benefits. This case was held in abeyance pending the completion of KCPL's general rate case. In light of the Commission's Report and Order in that case, the Commission ordered the parties to inform the Commission whether this case can be closed.

On April 12, 2007, KCPL filed a Notice of Dismissal. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a party may dismiss an application without an order of the Commission before prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered. The parties have not offered prepared testimony or oral evidence. The Commission, therefore, will take notice of the dismissal. This case may be closed.
