ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On January 31, 2014, Midwest Energy Consumer's Group, joined by Missouri Industrial Consumers and Staff of the Public Service Commission, filed a *Motion for Reconsideration and Motion for Expedited Treatment*. The Commission issued an order setting a deadline for parties to file a response by February 3, 2014. On February 3, 2014, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") (jointly "Companies") filed a joint motion requesting an extension of time to file a response to the *Motion for Reconsideration and Motion for Expedited Treatment*. Companies state the reason the request should be granted is due to a similar motion from Ameren Missouri being granted by the Commission. However, unlike Ameren Missouri, which filed its motion requesting additional time to respond prior to the February 3, 2014 deadline, counsel for Companies do not assert a conflict on February 3, 2014.

Since the Commission must have an opportunity to review all responses prior to issuing an order and Companies failed to show good cause for why their motion should be granted, the Commission will deny Companies' request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The joint motion for additional time to file a response filed by Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company is denied.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
