**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ACKNOWLEDGING AUTOMATIC
PARTIES, AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES FOR INTERVENTION
AND REQUESTING A HEARING**

On March 4, 2022, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed notice that it started its prudence audit of the fuel adjustment clause established for Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, for the period June 1, 2020, through September 30, 2021. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(11)(B) requires Staff to file its recommendation regarding the prudence review no later than 180 days after it initiates the review. Pursuant to the same rule, other parties to the case have 10 days after Staff files its prudence review recommendation to request a hearing.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(17)(A) provides that parties to the most recent general rate proceeding in which the Commission established, modified, or continued the fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this prudence review proceeding. The Commission acknowledges the parties to File No. ER-2021-0240 as parties to this case without the need to apply to intervene. The Data Center shall add these parties to the service list, and shall send a copy of this order to them.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(17)(B) provides that anyone may seek to intervene in any FAC prudence review proceeding. The Commission will set a deadline for intervention applications.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall add the parties from File No. ER-2021-0240 to the certified service list for this file, and shall send a copy of this order to them.
2. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than April 4, 2022.
3. Staff shall file its recommendation no later than August 31, 2022.
4. Any request for a hearing shall be filed no later than ten days after Staff files its recommendation.
5. This order shall be effective when issued.
