**ORDER GRANTING MOTION
TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE
AND TO ADOPT DISCOVERY PROCEDURES**

The Commission has issued an order setting a procedural schedule and setting dates for an evidentiary hearing. As part of the order, the parties are required to file rebuttal testimony on September 23, 2013. On September 17, 2013, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion to move the filing of rebuttal testimony to September 24. Staff also, on behalf of all of the parties, requests that the Commission adopt certain discovery procedures.

The Commission finds the motion reasonable and will grant the requested relief. The Commission will extend by one day, the one which the parties must file rebuttal testimony. Also, the Commission will direct the parties to abide by the discovery procedures as set out in the body of Staff's motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Modify the Procedural Schedule and Adopt Discovery Procedures is granted.
2. The parties shall file rebuttal testimony on September 24, 2013, rather than September 23.

3. The parties shall adhere to the discovery guidelines as set out in the body of the Staff of the Commission's motion.

4. This order shall become effective on September 19, 2013.
