On December 17, 2015, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed its LED Lighting Update Report in compliance with the *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding MEEIA Low Income Exemption and LED Streetlighting Issues*, which was submitted in File No. ER-2014-0258 and approved by the Commission on March 21, 2015. The City of O’Fallon and the Missouri Department of Economic Development-Division of Energy filed timely applications to intervene. The Commission will provide an opportunity for other parties to respond to the applications to intervene. The response time will be shortened to allow parties to submit recommendations on Ameren Missouri’s LED Lighting Update Report and tariff before the December 31, 2015 deadline.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to the City of O’Fallon and the Missouri Department of Economic Development-Division of Energy’s applications to intervene shall do so no later than 12:00 p.m. noon on December 29, 2015.

2. This order shall become effective when issued.
