## MOTION TO RESCHEDULE RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), by and through undersigned counsel, for its *Motion to Reschedule Recommendation*, respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On January 18,<sup>1</sup> Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") filed a tariff proposing to suspend the payment of solar rebates, and an application seeking approval of the tariff, bearing an effective date of March 18.
- 2. On January 19, the Commission issued its *Notice and Order Setting Dates* for Filings, wherein Staff is directed to file a recommendation on the application and tariff not later than February 10.
- 3. Staff has filed Data Requests necessary for Staff's report, and Staff believes that KCPL will be unable to produce the information in enough time for Staff to thoroughly review the data and draft its recommendation by February 10.
- 4. Staff requests that the Commission reschedule the assignment date of its recommendation to permit KCPL an opportunity to provide Staff with the information requested necessary for Staff's recommendation. Staff asks the Commission to accept Staff's Recommendation not later than March 1.<sup>2</sup>

5. This request should not prejudice any party and should allow the Commission an opportunity review the filed materials and make decision in this matter effective within 60 days of the filing of this Application, pursuant to § 393.1030.3, RSMo.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff requests that the Commission revise the submission dates from its previous order and accept Staff's recommendation in this case not later than March 1, 2016.
