**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND
ESTABLISHING TIME FOR RESPONSES**

On November 12, 2019, Evergy Metro, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri West filed a request for a variance from the Commission’s billing and payment standards. The applicants want a waiver from the Commission requirement for residential bills stating the beginning and ending meter readings for customers who choose to use Time of Use (TOU) rates because those meter reads are not relevant to the bill under a TOU rate.

The Commission will order notice of this application, and will set a date for intervention requests.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the county commissions in Evergy Metro, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri West’s service territories.

2. The Commission’s Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make this notice available to the members of the General Assembly serving in Evergy Metro, Inc.,

d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri West's service territory.

3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than November 23, 2019.

4. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation no later than November 27, 2019.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
