ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On December 1, 2021, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (collectively Evergy) filed their *Application for Approval of the Income-Eligible Weatherization Tariff, Automation of the Income-Eligible Weatherization Program, and Motion for Variance of 60-Day Notice*. On December 6, 2021, the Commission issued its order directing notice and setting a deadline of December 15, 2021 for requests to intervene.

On December 3, 2021, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri (Renew Missouri) applied to intervene and the Commission issued its order establishing time to respond to that application on or before December 9, 2021. The period established to respond has elapsed and no party has objected to Renew Missouri's application to intervene.¹ The application satisfies the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

¹ Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(13) provides that parties shall be allowed ten days from the date of filing in which to respond to any pleading unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene filed by Renew Missouri is granted.
2. This order is effective when issued.
