ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

Issue Date: June 1, 2023

Effective Date: June 12, 2023

On January 13, 2023, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed tariff sheets, assigned Tracking No. JE-2023-0124, designed to revise Ameren Missouri's rates for cogeneration and net metering as required by Commission Rules 20 CSR 4240-3.155, 20 CSR 4240-20.060, and 20 CSR 4240-20.065. The tariff sheets had an original effective date of February 12, 2023. The Commission suspended the tariff sheets until June 12, 2023.

On May 23, 2023, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation. Staff recommended the Commission approve the tariff sheets to become effective on June 12, 2023. Staff also recommended that for "future cogeneration tariff rate filings Ameren Missouri provide calculations and all supporting documentation to justify the

Ameren Missouri position associated with the avoided capacity credit treatment within the proposed cogeneration tariff rate.”¹ No response to Staff’s recommendation was filed.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff’s recommendation and determines that the tariff sheets should be approved. Additionally, the Commission will direct Ameren Missouri to file the information requested by Staff in its next cogeneration tariff filing. The Commission will approve the tariff sheets to become effective on June 12, 2023. So that the tariff sheets may become effective as requested, the Commission finds it reasonable for this order to become effective in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff sheets submitted by Ameren Missouri on January 13, 2023, Tracking No. JE-2023-0124, are approved to be effective on June 12, 2023. The tariff sheets approved are:

2. In its next cogeneration tariff rate filing, Ameren Missouri shall provide to Staff the calculations and all supporting documentation to justify its position associated with the avoided capacity credit treatment within the proposed cogeneration tariff rate.

3. This order shall be effective on June 12, 2023.

4. This file shall close on June 13, 2023.
