## ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE REPORT

On August 27, 2014, the Commission directed its Staff to investigate the compliance of Kansas City Power & Light Company, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, and Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(4) regarding solar rebate payments to their retail account holders. Staff was directed to file either its final report, or a status report regarding its investigation, no later than October 6.

On October 6, Staff filed a status report indicating it needs additional time to complete its investigation and to file its report. Staff asks that it be allowed until October 30 to file its final report. The Commission will grant Staff's request for more time.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall file either its final report, or a status report regarding its investigation, no later than October 30, 2014.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
