**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION AND  
ESTABLISHING TIME FOR OTHER PARTIES TO RESPOND**

On November 20, 2013, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a request asking the Commission to waive certain provisions of its Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) rules. Ameren Missouri seeks those waivers in connection with a tariff it has filed to implement its plan to recover MEEIA costs. Ameren Missouri's tariff will become effective on January 27, 2014.

Before acting on Ameren Missouri's request, the Commission will require a recommendation from its Staff. The Commission will also establish a time for the filing of a response to Staff's recommendation by any party that wishes to do so.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Request for Waivers no later than December 10, 2013.
2. Any party wishing to respond to Staff's recommendation regarding Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Request for Waivers shall do so no later than December 20, 2013.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
