## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

In its September 9, 2015<sup>1</sup> Agenda meeting, the Commission directed the parties to report to the Commission whether they could continue negotiating a MEEIA plan that would include retrospective Evaluation, Measurement, and Verification ("EM&V"), and that would also include a Performance Incentive that has a component of supply-side investment reduction. The Commission ordered the parties to respond no later than September 16.

On September 16, Ameren Missouri, the Staff of the Commission, and the Missouri Division of Energy asked that the Commission allow them until September 22 to continue to negotiate. The Commission finds the parties' request reasonable, and will grant it.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than September 22, 2015, the parties shall file a pleading or pleadings stating whether they believe they can negotiate a MEEIA plan that would include retrospective Evaluation, Measurement, and Verification ("EM&V"), and that would also include a Performance Incentive that has a component of supply-side investment reduction.
