ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION FOR AUTHORITY TO MANAGE SULFUR DIOXIDE AND NITROGEN OXIDE ALLOWANCE INVENTORY

On June 2, 2015, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application seeking authority to manage its Cross-State Air Pollution Rule (CSAPR) sulfur dioxide (SO₂) and nitrogen oxide (NOx) emission allowances inventory. The Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation about that application by July 6, and directed any other party wishing to respond to the motion to do so by that date. On June 24, Staff filed a motion asking that it be allowed until July 31 to file its recommendation. Staff represents that the requested extension is acceptable to Ameren Missouri.

Staff finds Staff's request for additional time to be reasonable and will grant the requested extension.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Application for Authorization to Manage its Sulfur Dioxide Emission and Nitrogen Oxide Allowance Inventory no later than July 31, 2015.
- 2. Any other party wishing to respond to Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Application for Authorization to Manage its Sulfur Dioxide Emission and Nitrogen Oxide Allowance Inventory may do so no later than July 31, 2015.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
